in preparation of the European certification and diploma in endoscopic surgery

at the 9th Annual Meeting on Robotic Gynaecological Surgery

Dear participant at the congress,

***Now that we have certification and a European diploma
in gynaecological endoscopy....***

We cordially invite you to come train and test your laparoscopic psychomotor skills during an ESGE Laparoscopic Skills Workshop organized in collaboration with the European Academy of Gynaecological Surgery.

The workshop consists of different, scientific validated, exercises on pelvi-trainer according to the LASTT (Laparoscopic Skills Training and Testing) and SUTT (Suturing Skills Training and Testing) methods. These three-hour sessions can host 40 participants, under the guidance of experts in this method.

After registration on the on-line scoring platform, you will be tested on the different psychomotor skills. An individual and detailed report of your result will be sent to you by e-mail a few days later. Your results will be compared with benchmark data and expressed via a colour code (green: excellent, yellow: fair and red: room for improvement).

This is only a test but we have to stress its importance since the test is a part of an actual European certification and diploma programme.

The Gynaecological Endoscopic Surgical Education and Assessment or GESEA programme is elaborated by the European Society for Gynaecological Endoscopy (ESGE) in collaboration with the European Academy of Gynaecological Surgery (+he Academy). This well-balanced diploma curriculum is based on the current best scientific knowledge and has been approved by several European and North-American scientific Societies (ESHRE, EBCOG, ENTOG, AAGL, ACOG).

Certification of your endoscopic skills, so often recognized as obvious and mandatory, is now within reach. The workshop is offered to you as a possibility to make a first step in this direction.

We are looking forward to welcoming you to the ESGE Laparoscopic Skills Workshop during the SERGS meeting in Lille, France 14-16.06.2017.
